A message from our Principal

The students at Alkimos Beach PS have had a fantastic fortnight with lots of exciting events for them to enjoy. The last two weeks started with the Interschool Athletics Carnival, where selected students from Year 4 to 6 participated in running races and team games. It turned out to be a beautiful day, with the sun coming out after a bit of light rain. I would like to congratulate all students for being a good sport, displaying persistence and resilience throughout the day and cheering on our school. Well done to Tyleaa and Matthew who received champion girl and boy for their year level and Kaelah who received runner up champion girl for her year.

On Wednesday, students enjoyed a free incursion with performances from the Constable Care team. Students in Pre-Primary to Year 2 viewed a performance about Timmy, Teagan and Sarge The Dog at the park enjoying a beautiful afternoon. They get butterflies in their tummies as they zoom down the big slide and their hearts pound with excitement playing chasey. They realise that it can be pretty fun to feel a little scared, but not always. There's a difference between fun-scary and bad-scary. Timmy and Teagan learn that there is always a safe person to talk to about the bad-scary stuff. This fun play helped children identify feelings, increasing emotional literacy and supported them in identifying safe adults to talk to. Whereas our Year 3-6 students viewed a performance about Jasper who is the new kid in school and is having a hard time fitting in – how can you help? With the overarching aim of bullying prevention this show helps children develop pro-social skills and supports them in creating and promoting a culture of respect and consideration amongst their school community. This interactive performance encourages students to think about how their behaviour can affect other people, seeing them build confidence in social situations, making friends and developing resilience.

Lastly, students participated in a "Footy Final's Colours and P&C Jesters Meal Deal day. Thank you to all that supported this day with \$315.55 being raised from the Footy Finals Colours and \$351.50 from the Jesters Meal deal day going towards the Year 6 graduation events later in the year.


Just a reminder, next week is the last week of Term 3 with students breaking on the 21st September and returning on Monday 8th October with school photos occurring in Week 1.

Our school photo day is coming! Every student has received a Kapture Photography order envelope to bring home. The recommended method of ordering your photos is online through Kapture's website as your payment is secure and can be easily verified at any time. If you pay online, there is no need to return the order envelope to school.

Alternatively you can pay by cash and return the provided envelope to the school **on the photography day**. Please note the photographers cannot open sealed envelopes and cannot provide change.

SIBLING ORDERS CAN ONLY BE PLACED ONLINE: Late requests cannot be granted.

You have the option to order a sibling photo package online. We suggest you place your online sibling order as soon as you receive your order envelope with your order instructions. Log on to kapture.com.au for your sibling photo order cut-off date and time

Late payment envelopes cannot be accepted by the school office or by Kapture. You can place an order online for class or individual photographs at any time for the remainder of the current school year however a \$15 fee will apply if you order more than 10 days after photography.

All students will be photographed individually on photo day for school administration records AS WELL as included in their class group photo available for purchase to all families. ALKIMOS BEACH PRIMARY SCHOOL - BLUE WAVE CAFÉ




