As it is school holidays we ask the community to keep an extra eye out for the school and to report any suspicious activity to the police 13 14 44 or school security 07 3244 5328.


Have a wonderful and safe Christmas and New Year and we look forward to seeing you in 2019.

Talks to a Saver Plus Coordinator from a community organisation and, if eligible for the program, sets a goal to save a regular amount of money over 10 months

Opens an ANZ Progress Saver account and makes regular deposits

Who can join?

Participants must meet all of the below criteria:

- hevo a Controlink Hoalth Caro or Ponsionor Concession Card
- bost losst 18 years old
- have some regular income from work (themselves or their partner)
- have a child at school or attend vocational education themselves.

How did it start?

Sever Plus bogen in 2003 as a Brotherhood of St Leurence and ANZ pilot program with 268 participants in three sites across Victoria and New South Wales.

Since then, the program has expanded to all Australian states and territories, reaching more than 32,000 people, making it the largest and longest-running program of its kind in the world.

Since 20041:

- 32,000+ participants
- \$17.3m total amount saved by participants
- \$14m metched funds paid by ANZ
- \$753 average amount saved per participant
