


FIREFIGHTER INCURSION

- 3. Show respect to others with appropriate conversation and empathy.
- 4. Be responsible. Do what you say you will do.
- 5. Work together as a team to build trust.
- 6. Do not let someone else take the blame for something you did.

CHILDREN'S BEHAVIOUR - THE TOUGHEST PART OF PARENTING



Of all the things parents must do, dealing with children's behaviour can be the most stressful AND the most challenging!! Parent's having realistic expectations of misbehaviour is important.

Some misbehaviour you see in your child is normal and some discipline problems are going to happen regardless of what you do. Although, if we are able to manage everyday behaviour problems (like deliberately choosing not to follow our instructions, fighting with their siblings or other children and refusing to go to bed)

when children are young, we can prevent more serious problems such as stealing, lying, getting into trouble at school and involvement with drugs when children are older.

Triple P (or Positive Parenting Program) is an approach to raising children that aims to promote children's development and manage children's behaviour and emotions in a positive and non-hurtful way. Attending the first seminar series called: *The Power of Positive Parenting* will provide parents with information on what things they can be doing at home, that aims to prevent, or at the very least, reduce how often your child misbehaved and how severe their misbehaviour is at home.
