We have BeachSafe starting Tuesday for Year 2-6 students. The Surf Lifesaving (SLSWA) do a terrific job instructing our students on being safe around open water and it is a great follow up to our swimming lessons. We also have our Year 6 students holding a Pyjama Day on Friday 21st October with all gold coin donations going towards their graduation.
